

# Configuring JDBC Drivers

This topic explains how to configure any JDBC drivers required by C++test (e.g., to connect to a database used for parameterized tests).

## Configuring JDBC Drivers

To configure JDBC driver settings:

1. Choose **Parasoft> Preferences** to open the Preferences panel.
2. Select **Available JDBC Drivers** on the left.
3. Add the required drivers to the classpath.
