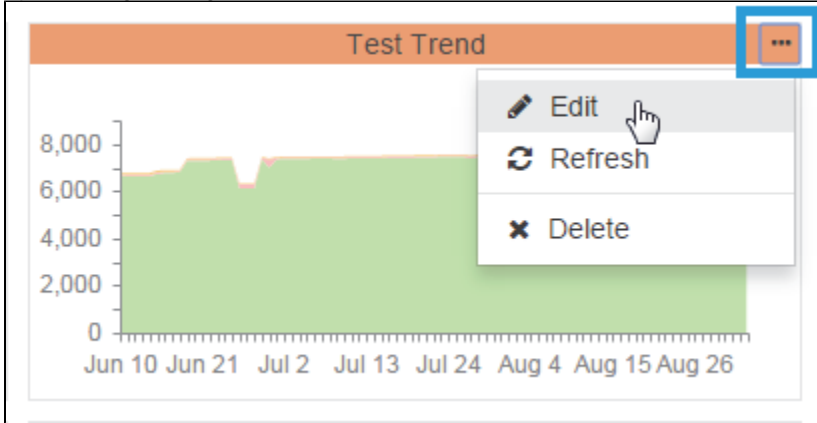


# Managing Widgets


## Editing Widget Settings

You can make changes to a widget's filter settings after it has been created. You can not change the widget type or subtype in the widget editor. Create a new widget to choose a different widget type or subtype. See [Adding Widgets](#) for information about filters and widget settings.

1. Open the widget management menu and click **Edit**.



2. Make your changes to the widget settings. See [Widget](#) for information about available settings.

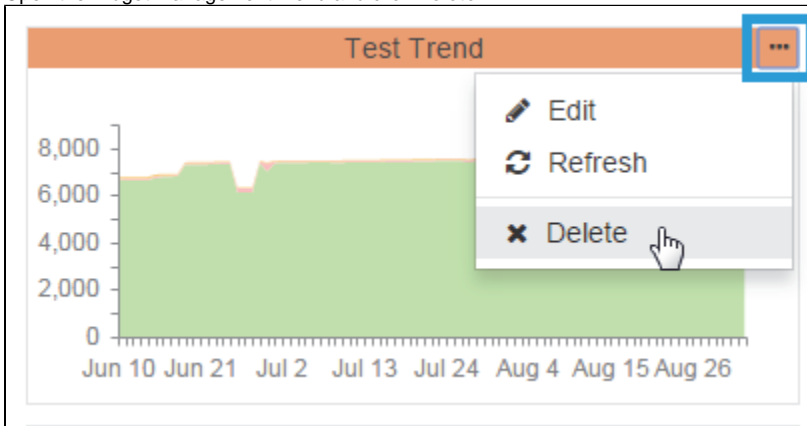

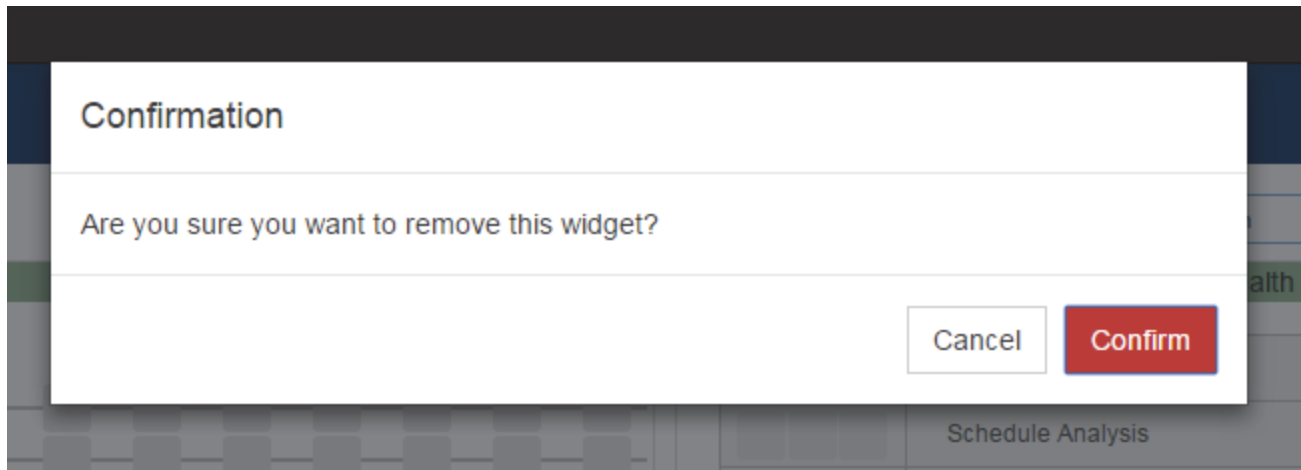
3. Click **Save** to accept changes.

Open the widget management menu and click **Refresh** to update the data for individual widgets without refreshing the data in all widgets in the dashboard.
