Title	Enter a new title to replace the default title that appears on the dashboard. A widget title is required.
Width / Height	See About the Dashboard Grid.

The Custom HTML widget stylesheet removes several default browser styles: a, abbr, acronym, address, b, big, blockquote, body, caption, cite, code, dd, del, dfn, div, dl, dt, em, embed, fieldset, figcaption, figure, footer, form, h1, h2, h3, h4, h5, h6, html, i, iframe, img, ins, kbd, label, legend, li, object, ol, p, pre, q, samp, small, span, strike, strong, sub, sup, table, tbody, td, tfoot, th, thead, tr, tt, ul, var. As a workaround, you can add a style attribute and define inline CSS, for example:
